Another labor pain management option Nitrous oxide, also known as laughing gas, is another pain management option for laboring mothers at Riverwood.


If you are interested in medication for pain relief during labor and delivery, talk to your provider and include it in your birth plan.

Robotic surgery speeds recovery for hernia repair

Approximately 600,000 inguinal or groin hernia repair operations are performed annually in the United States. In northern Minnesota, most hernia surgeries—about 80%—are still being done with open instead of laparoscopic or minimally invasive procedures. At Riverwood, we specialize in minimally invasive surgery, using robotic surgery to repair hernias. This newer technique offers surgeons greater precision with three-dimensional images of the inside of the abdomen. Benefits for patients include smaller scars, less pain and a faster recovery.

Five general surgeons offer hernia repair with the da Vinci® Xi System, a leading-edge robotic surgical system. Learn more about hernias and treatment below.

What's a hernia?

A hernia occurs when tissue bulges through an opening in the muscles of your abdomen (ventral hernia) or groin area (inguinal hernia). These can be present at birth, develop over time, or occur at the site of an old incision.

What are the benefits of robotic surgery for hernia repair? Robotic surgery for hernia repair brings together the benefits of laparoscopic surgery with the dexterity of open techniques. With this minimally invasive approach, incisions are very small—about 1/2 inch—compared to 4-inch or larger incisions with an open procedure. With the robotic equipment, the surgeon has a 3D view with a magnified image of 10 times the actual size and Improved ergonomics and dexterity with wristed instruments. With smaller incisions, there is less operative trauma, less pain and less need

for pain medication. A patient can get back to their normal activities sooner.

What happens when you delay getting a hernia repaired? Hernias tend to become larger and more symptomatic over time. Even when your symptoms are minimal, consider any limitations your hernia puts on your time and activities. Keep in mind that delaying surgery until your hernia is larger may make surgery and recovery more difficult.

What can a patient expect after surgery?

Immediately after the hernia surgery, the patient will be transported to the recovery area for 1-2 hours. Most patients go home the day of surgery. For more complex procedures, a patient may need to stay overnight in the hospital.

It is normal to be sore. This can often be controlled with Tylenol and ibuprofen. Sometimes stronger pain medications are necessary. The patient is encouraged to be up and about the day of the surgery and to slowly resume normal activities. Lifting limitations may apply. A follow-up with the surgeon is scheduled 1-2 weeks after surgery.

If you think you may have a hernia, don't wait. See your healthcare provider. If you would like to schedule an appointment with a general surgeon at Riverwood's specialty clinic, call 218-927-5566. Appointments can typically be scheduled within a week. •

Hernia Patient Success Story

When Kevin White was examined by a general surgeon at Riverwood Healthcare Center for hernia treatment, he was given two choices. He could have surgery the traditional way with an open procedure or performed with a robotic-assisted minimally invasive approach.

"The surgeon told me the robotic-assisted surgery would be less painful with a faster recovery, so that's what I opted to do," Kevin says. "I got to view the robotic equipment before my surgery and it was pretty cool with all those different arms and computer-guided controls."

Kevin checked in for surgery about 9:30 a.m. and was on his way home by mid-afternoon. The hernia surgical procedure took less than an hour.

"I thought the operation was pretty smooth," Kevin says. "The entire surgery crew at Riverwood was great. The head surgery nurse came and talked to me before and after my operation. She and everyone in the OR was so nice."

Kevin had very little pain in recovery with minimal bruising or swelling. At his 10-day post-op check-up, the surgeon told him he didn't need to be seen again unless any issues arose.

"I'm very happy with my minimally invasive hernia surgery," Kevin adds. "I only had to have four tiny incisions that healed up so fast. My incisions are barely visible."


Quick solution for knee pain


